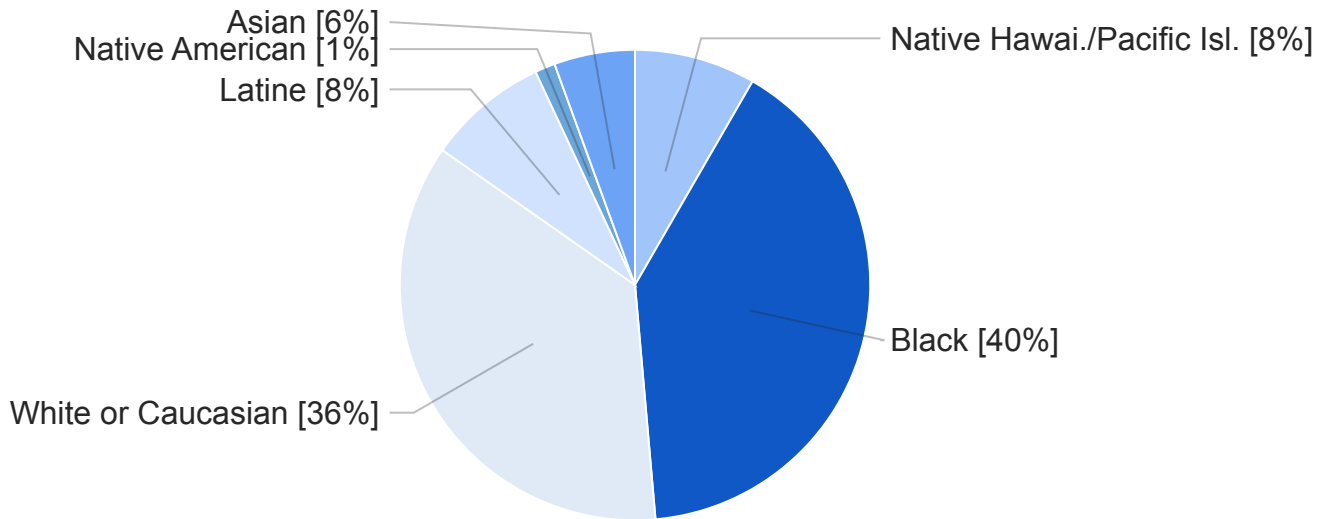
This data is all gathered at intake. Many of the stats change as families and individuals connect to resources when they arrive to make progress toward housing.



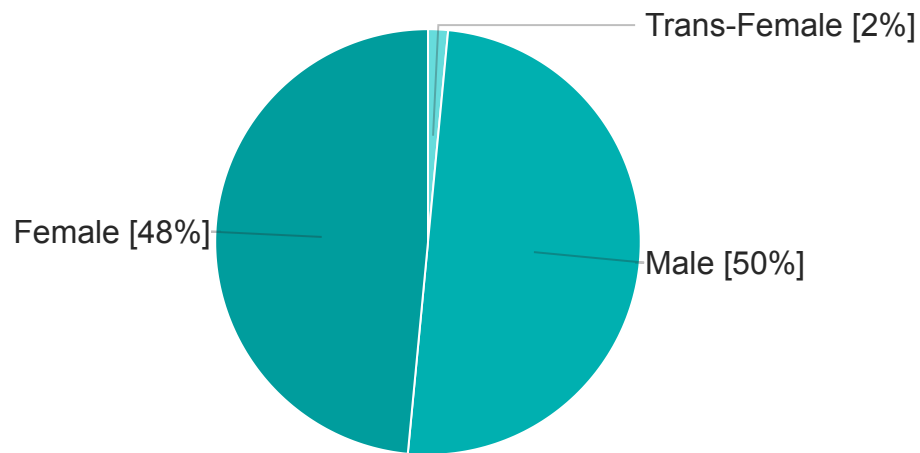

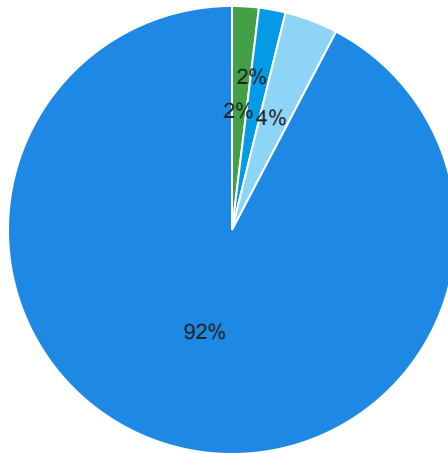

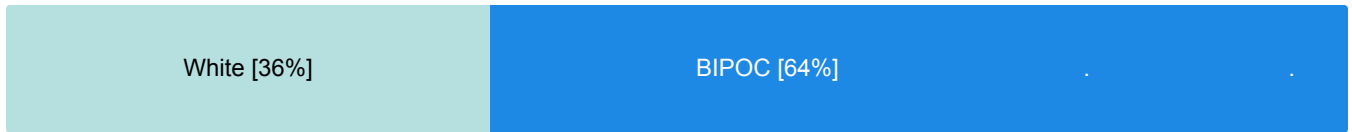

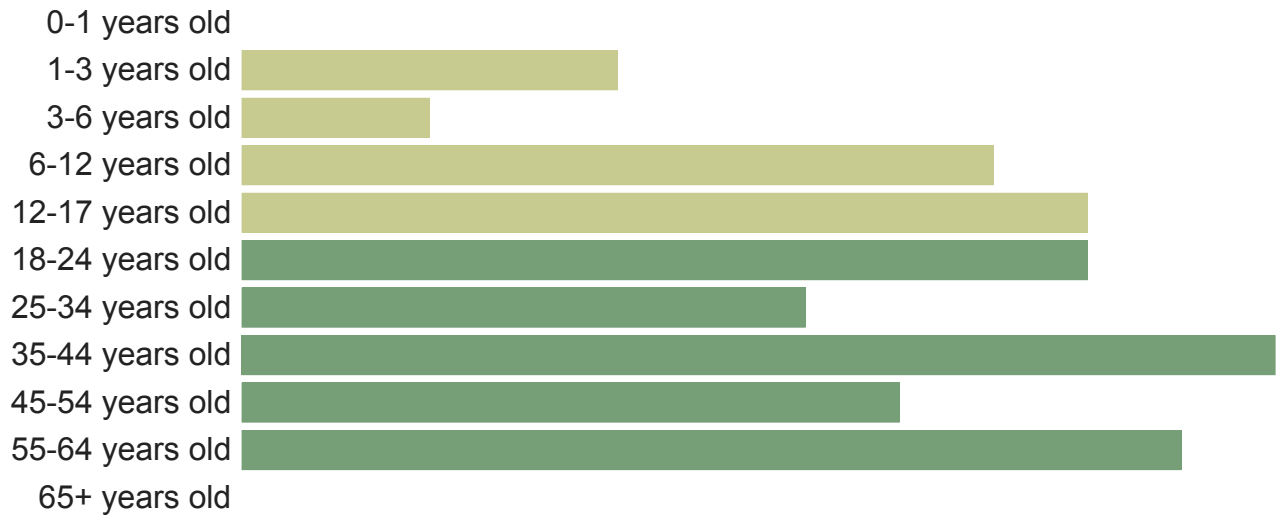

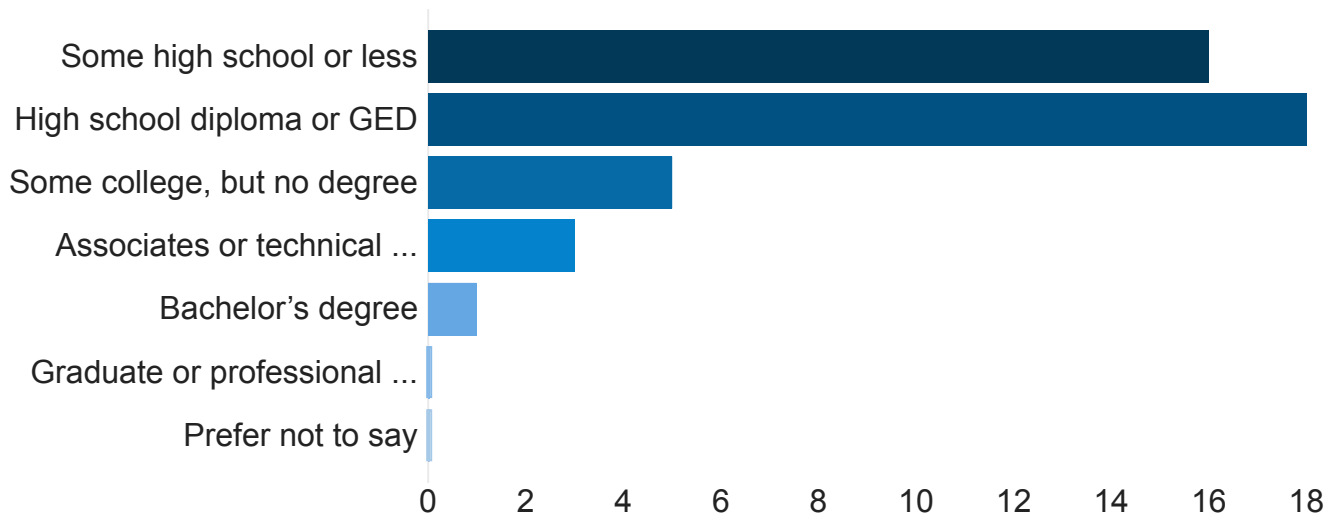

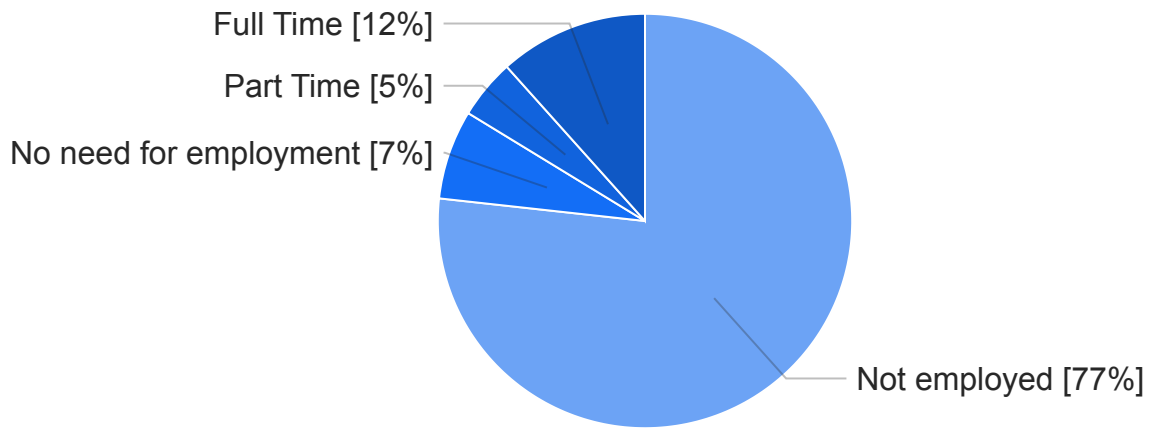

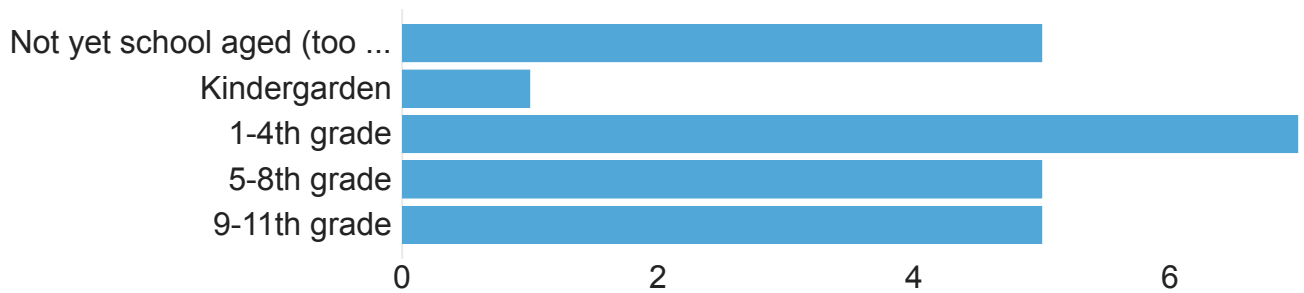

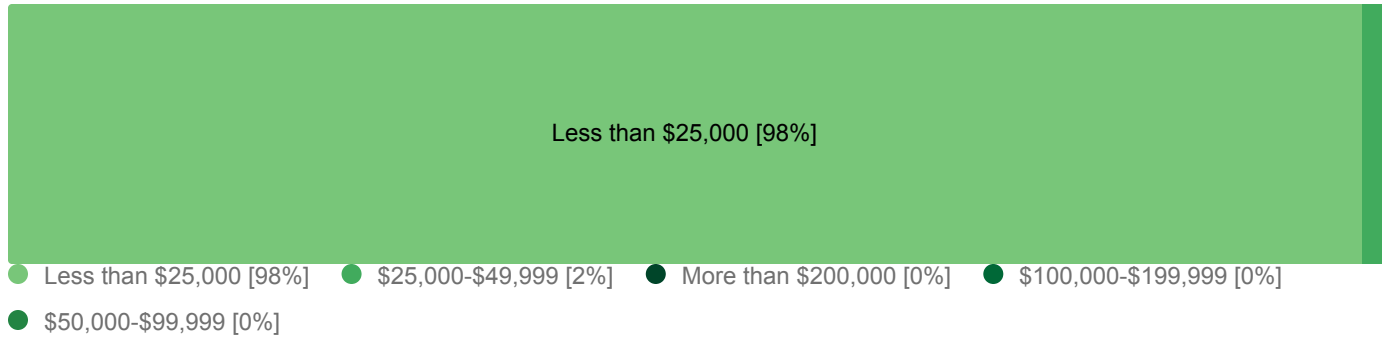
Guest children enrolled in school/day care at entry?

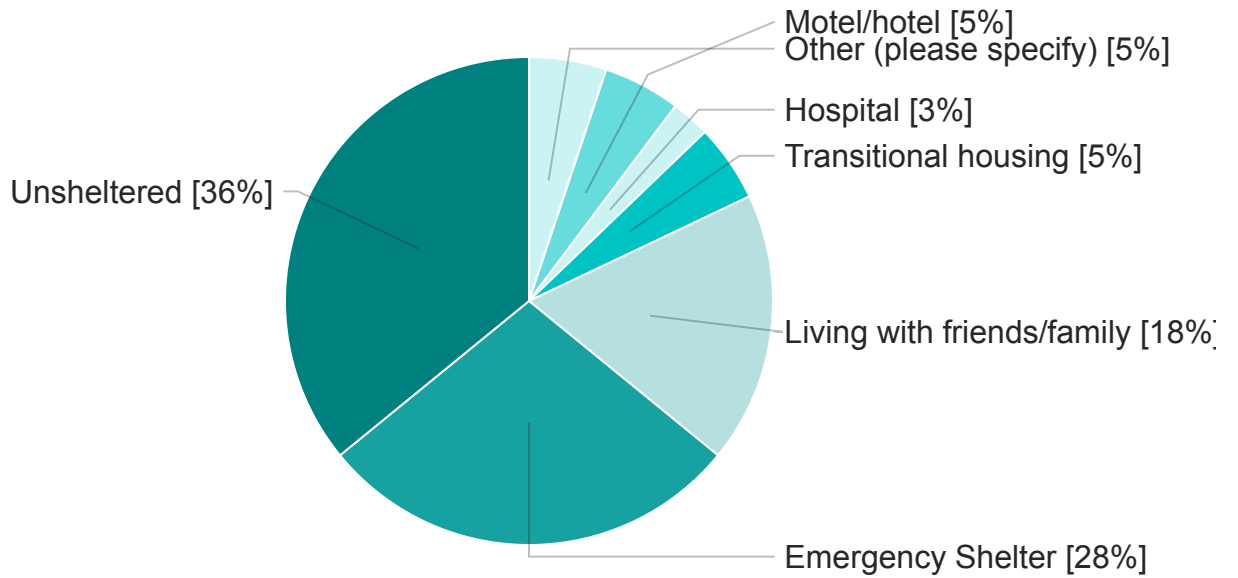


Household income before taxes during the past 12 months

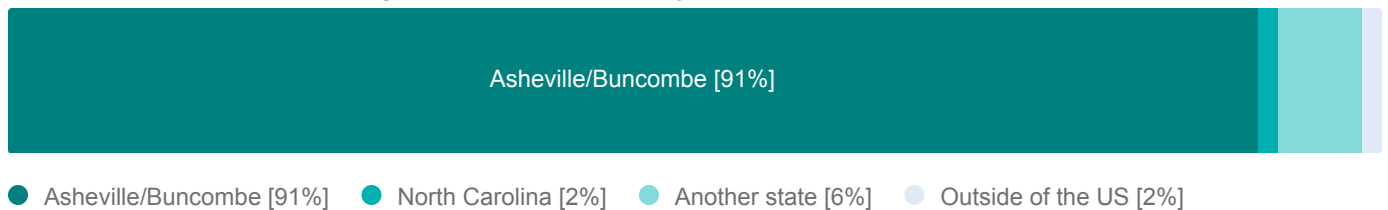

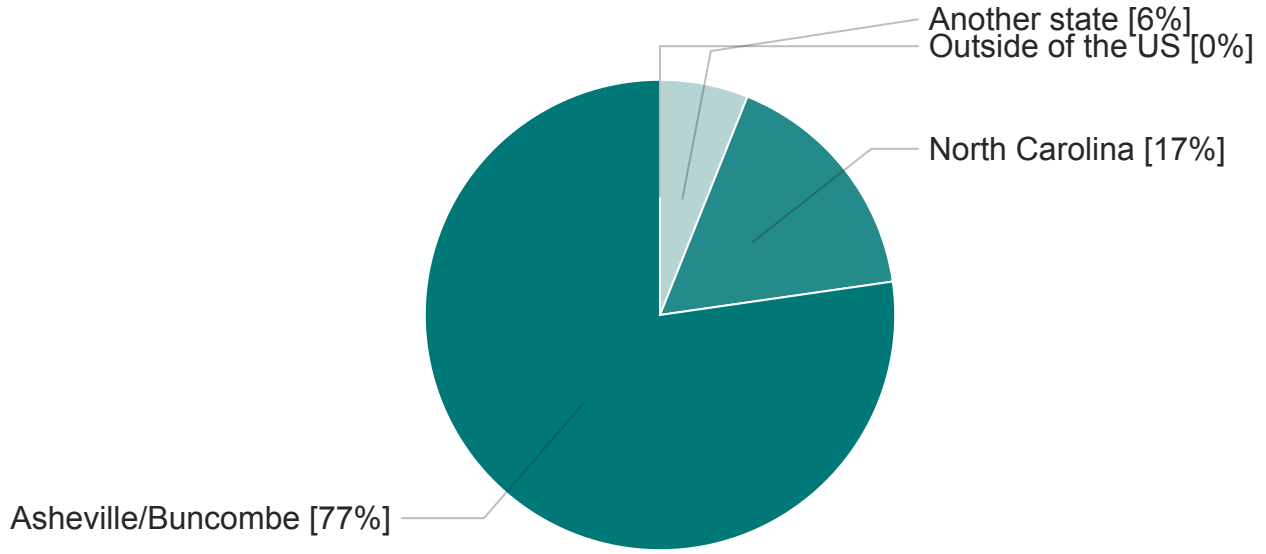
Where did you spend the last three nights?



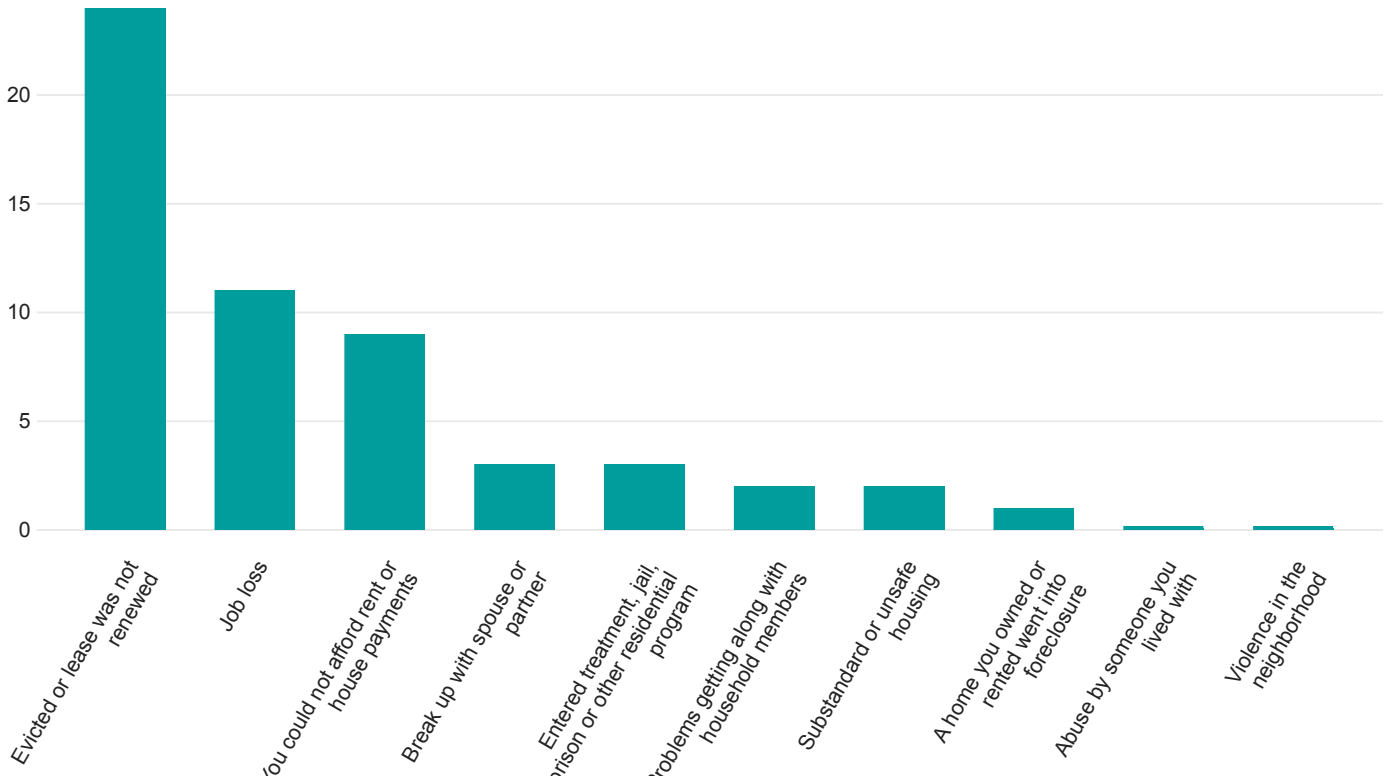
Location of last 3 nights before entry to Safe Shelter



In what location did you spend the last 30 nights?



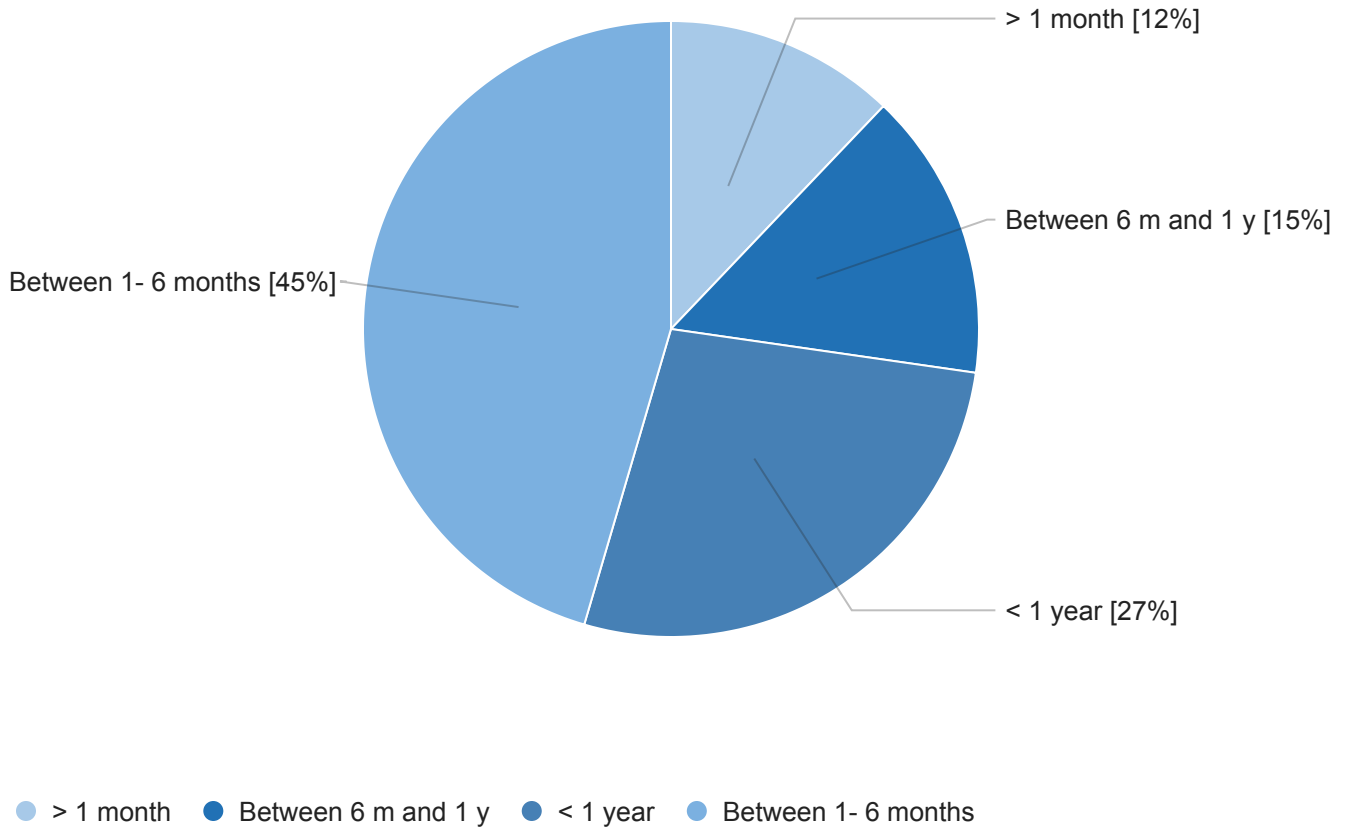
Reason for losing last housing situation.

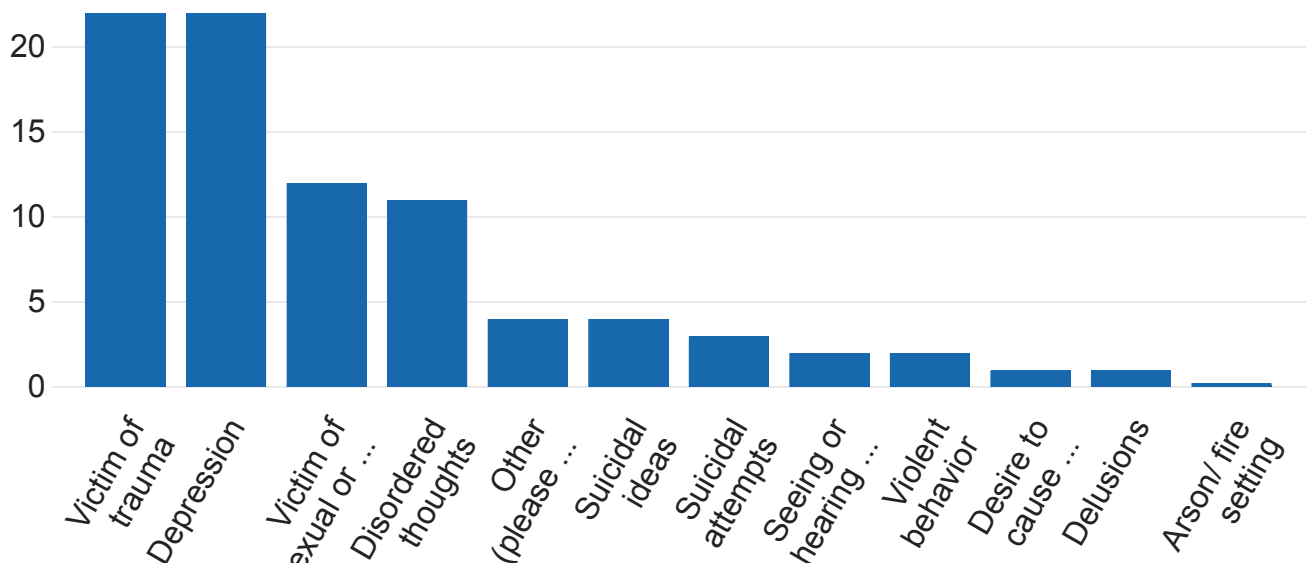

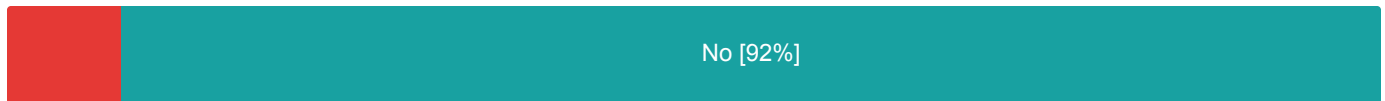
